

***Transfiguration of the Lord Parish - Faith Formation Office
Service Projects - Ninth Grade***

Purpose: Service is a means for the Confirmation Candidate to share his/her understanding of the true meaning of discipleship with others. It allows each candidate to give thanks for the gifts that God has graciously granted upon them.

Service is: The tasks performed or talents shared with others, without receipt of monetary or personal gain in return.

Candidates are expected to do three projects:

- 1. Service to the Community:*** examples: volunteering at schools: Hoops for Heart; Walk-A-Thon for a good cause; helping neighbors with yard work, soup kitchen.
- 2. Service to the Community or Service to our parish:*** volunteer for the Faith Formation program, be an altar server, help at activities at a church such as, parish fair, help with Food Bank.
- 3. Service to their family:*** Immediate family and/or relatives. Help with projects around the house, help siblings with schoolwork.
